

Lunar Refrigeration Ltd is committed to preventing acts of modern-day slavery & human trafficking within its own business and from within its supply chains. The Company acknowledges responsibility to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and will ensure transparency within its organisation and the suppliers of goods and services to Lunar.

The Lunar business structure is a joint venture, which holds a contract to manage the procurement assembly and supply of goods to its customers. Within the supply of goods there are relationships with external businesses for the sourcing of products. These as well as the suppliers of services, make up the supply chains within Lunar Refrigeration Ltd.

As part of the company’s due diligence processes into slavery and human trafficking, the supplier approval process will incorporate a review of the controls undertaken by the supplier. Imported produce from sources from outside of the UK and EU are potentially more at risk for slavery/human trafficking issues. The level of management control required for these sources will be continually monitored.

The Company will not support or deal with any business knowingly involved in slavery or human trafficking.

The Managing Director will be responsible to the Company Directors for implementing this policy statement and its objectives and shall provide adequate resources, training and investment to ensure that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place within the organisation or its supply chains.

This policy statement will be reviewed annually and published.
