Responsibility	Lunar Ltd Commitment
Client Support	Ensure that clients understand their duties under CDM before any work starts.
Project Management	Plan, manage, and monitor all work to safeguard workers and affected parties, including the public.
Construction Phase Plan	Prepare a written plan before work starts, review it regularly, and update as needed.
Competence & Training	Ensure all workers have or are gaining the appropriate skills, knowledge, training, and experience (SKATE).
Site Induction	Deliver site-specific inductions to all workers under Lunar Ltd's control.
Supervision & Instruction	Provide appropriate supervision, instructions, and information to all workers.
Site Access Control	Prevent unauthorised access through reasonable and practical measures.
Welfare Facilities	Provide and maintain appropriate on-site welfare provisions.
Contractor Coordination	Coordinate with other contractors to ensure health and safety measures are integrated.

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## 4. Organisational Capability

Lunar Ltd possesses the necessary organisational capability, including staff competence, procedures, and safety systems, to undertake works in compliance with CDM Regulations.
